## Definitions

Statutory Requirements - Laws passed by a state and/or central government.

Regulatory Requirements - A rule issued by a regulatory body appointed by a state and/or central government

Standard - Documented procedure whose intention is to harmonize actions or processes within a specific discipline or activity. Standard procedures have broad acceptance within specific groups but are not laws established by government agencies.
